

How to Participate in Sports at Bear Creek High School:

1. Players are required to have a current physical (see information below) *and* . . .
 2. Register with Bear Creek High School Athletics online [HERE](#) (See “Online Registration Tips” below) *and* . . .
 3. Register with CHSAA. Have your student send a text from his/her cell phone. Send Bear Creek’s school code, S41564, to phone number 69274. **Students have to register with CHSAA only 1 time during their high school career.**

Physicals:

Please use [THIS](#) form for a sports physical. If your medical provider prefers to use his or her own form, the form must contain the following information:

- Student's name and date of birth,
- The date of the physical,
- A statement that clearly states the student is, ***“Cleared to participate in sports,”***
- the medical provider's signature,
- Medical provider’s practice address and phone number.

All physicals are valid for 365 days.

A clear picture (of the whole document) or PDF of the current physical is required to be uploaded within the online Registration process every time a student registers for a sport.

Online Registration Tips:

First Time Users:

1. Begin by creating a Family Account with a valid, current email address.
2. The Registration system will send a confirmation email to this address.
3. *From within the confirmation email*, follow the link back to the Registration website.
4. Add student information and register for sport.
5. **** Upload a picture or PDF of your student’s current physical.**

Returning Users:

1. Login to your Family Account.
2. Choose or add the appropriate student.
3. Review the existing Registration Form and update as needed.
4. Select the sport you want to register for
5. **** Upload a picture or PDF of your student’s current physical.**

**** The Registration system will send reminder emails 3 weeks before, 2 weeks before, and 1 week before the physical expires.**

Athletic Fee:

Bear Creek High School's Athletic Fee is \$175 and is required for **each** sport your student plays. If your student has a waiver for Free or Reduced Fees, then that waiver will also waive this \$175 Athletic fee. The waiver **does not** cover other costs associated with being on a team, i.e. player pack fees, other equipment fees, etc.

Note: The waiver for free or reduced fees does not automatically renew every year. An [application has to be submitted](#) at the beginning of each school year.

- Athletic Fee Guidelines:
 - \$175 per athlete, per sport.
 - Refund Policy - A full refund will be made to the athlete who is cut or quits before being involved in the sport through fifteen calendar days.
 - The athletic fee refund must be claimed on or before the starting date of the next season, and within the same school year.



Eligibility:

All student athletes must be eligible for competition under the policies established by the Colorado High School Activities Association (CHSAA). These policies are on their website [HERE](#).

Bear Creek High School's Athletic Department runs a **Weekly Eligibility Report** every Wednesday. This report determines a student athlete's academic eligibility to compete the following week (Monday through Saturday).

A student athlete may compete with 1 F on the Eligibility Report, but with no more than 1F. Two or more Fs on the Weekly Eligibility Report mean the student-athlete is *not academically eligible* to compete the following week (Monday – Saturday).

In order to become academically eligible after the Weekly Eligibility Report has been run, the student athlete must bring his/her F grade up to a passing grade within the Infinite Campus grade book. His/her teacher should email Bear Creek's Athletic Director about the new grade before 2:00 p.m. on Friday of the week the report is run. The Athletic Director will communicate the student athlete's new grade to the respective coach.

Bear Creek High School Athletic Pass:

The Bear Creek Athletic Pass is an *optional* fee of \$60. This pass allows a student to attend regular season, home games for free. Students must present their school ID at all home games to gain admission.

Playoff events, tournaments and/or invitationals may charge higher rates. Playoff events will follow CHSAA guidelines for entry fees. Only CHSAA, CHSCA and CHSAA Media passes are accepted for free admission. No league passes, student athletic passes, employee passes, or staff passes will be accepted at these types of events.

Please note: If a student allows another student to use his/her pass, then the pass will be confiscated and privileges will be revoked, with no refund granted.
