Battlefield Hall of Fame Information

PURPOSE

The purpose of the Battlefield Athletics and Activities Hall of Fame is to recognize and honor those Battlefield High School student-athletes, coaches, and/or contributors who excelled in their respective roles to bring honor, recognition, distinction, and excellence to Battlefield High School.

GENERAL CRITERIA & ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Nominees must exemplify the highest standards of sportsmanship, ethical conduct, moral character, and carry the endorsement of Battlefield High School.

The categories of student-athlete, coach, and contributor are included on the nomination form for expediency in understanding the primary area in which an individual is to be considered for their achievements in Battlefield High School Athletics. The grouping is for screening purposes only and to assist those making the nominations in understanding the type of information required. Once nominees are inducted, they are recognized as members of the BHS Athletics Hall of Fame. The following criteria shall be met by the nominee in their respective category:

Student-athlete(s):

- Student-athletes are eligible for selection **5 years after their high school graduation**. Ex. graduated June **10**, 2022, eligibility begins after June **10**, 2027.
- Nominees shall be former participants at Battlefield who are being nominated for their achievements in interscholastic athletics during their student years at Battlefield.
- Play College or Pro Level
- Leader in the Community
- GPA
- Dual Sport Athlete
- Captain
- They must have competed in a VHSL-sanctioned varsity sport/activity and must have excelled in that sport/activity.
 - Accomplishments that are considered include, but are not limited to, individual (All-District, All-Region, All-State, All-Met, All-American) and team accomplishments (District, Region, or State Champions)
 - Individual or team/school records
 - Overall impact on Battlefield High School during their respective time as a student-athlete
 - Sustained positive character and impact in our community

Coach(es)

• Coaches being considered shall be retired and have had at least one (1) year of separation from Battlefield.

- Must have served AT LEAST 5 years at Battlefield High School.
- Shall have participated with distinction and/or made significant contributions to athletics and at Battlefield High School, as evidenced, by the success of their respective teams or programs while at Battlefield.
- Coaches may be eligible, in extenuating circumstances, as determined by the Selection Committee.

Contributor(s):

- Must be an individual who has contributed to interscholastic athletics at Battlefield in some capacity other than those previously mentioned, including, but not limited to such areas as administration, sports medicine, sports media, official, event personnel, activities sponsor or participant, etc.
- Shall have participated with distinction and made significant contributions to athletics and activities.
- Contributors may also be eligible, in extenuating circumstances, as determined by the Selection Committee.

ALL CANDIDATES WILL BE JUDGED ON THEIR SIGNIFICANT AND/OR LONG-TERM CONTRIBUTION TO INTERSCHOLASTIC

ATHLETICS AND ACTIVITIES WHILE AT BATTLEFIELD HIGH SCHOOL. WHILE MANY HAVE SERVED THEIR SCHOOL AND

PROGRAMS OVER A LONG AND DISTINGUISHED CAREER, THEIR ACCOMPLISHMENTS MUST HAVE BEEN WORTHY OF AT

LEAST DISTRICT/COUNTY RECOGNITION FOR THEM TO BE CONSIDERED. LONGEVITY, WITHOUT MEANINGFUL LOCAL

IMPACT, DOES NOT CONSTITUTE APPROPRIATE CREDENTIALS FOR HALL OF FAME CONSIDERATION.

METHODS OF NOMINATION & ELECTION

- 1. Any Battlefield High School or Prince William County School affiliate in good standing may nominate.
- 2. No individual may make more than one nomination per year.
- 3. Selection Committee members are **not** permitted to nominate.
- 4. Nominations for candidates not selected shall remain open for consideration each of the next two years but will no longer be considered thereafter, unless a new nomination packet is submitted.
- 5. The nominating deadline is June 1. Nomination packets submitted will be reviewed and selected by July 1. Notifications will be communicated no later than August 1 in advance of the Hall of Fame ceremony scheduled during the Home Varsity Football Game (The Hall of Fame Game). A formal invitation will be sent to the inductee. The Inductee and family will be recognized on the field at halftime.
