CHSAA Baseball Out of Season Competition Form

(Fruita Monument High School)



The following information is designed to help parents and players to determine the options they have for participation outside the high school baseball season. There are a number of teams available to the high school baseball player, including playing on the summer team sponsored/coached by the high school staff and other teams that provide varying experiences for the player.

It is important to note that these outside opportunities can include, but are not limited to, offerings from private organizations, teams loosely associated with coaches from other high schools and teams sponsored by coaches' associations in addition to teams sponsored by the player's own high school coach.

The Colorado Revised Statutes (CRS) and Colorado High School Activities Association by-laws address competition outside the high school season:

CRS 22-32-116.5 1 (c)

(c) No school or school district that receives funds under article 54 of this title shall belong to any organization or association nor enforce any rule of a coach or principal that would prohibit a student's participation in any school or interscholastic school activity based upon the student's participation in lawful activities during out-of-school hours and off of school property.

CHSAA By-law 2300.2 (page 84)

No coach or school representative may directly or by implication direct a student to participate in competition outside of the competitive season as a condition to participating or otherwise influencing a student's opportunity to participate in any school sport.

By the signing this documents, players, parents and coaches acknowledge their understanding that players and parents have no obligation to participate on any specified outside teams and that all options, including an outside team that may be associated with the player's high school, have been presented to them. The coach acknowledges that any future participation on the high school team cannot be tied to a player's participation on any outside team or outside season program, but are determined by that player's tryouts prior to the spring season.
