Itinerary

Admission to the field competition is \$5.00 for adults. All other competition sights are free. Times are subject to change.

- 6:15 AM Arrive in the band room in shorts (not short shorts), show shirts, long black socks, and band shoes. Watch the weather and bring/wear the appropriate clothing. We will load uniforms on the trailer and dress when we get to CMU. Load the trailer and take care of bathroom needs. Hats will stay in hat boxes and with you on the bus. Check to make sure you have both of your gloves.
- **7:00 AM Depart for Fayette.** Take care of your bathroom needs before we depart! We will not be stopping on the way. It is VERY possible that we'll get held up in parking traffic, so watch your liquid intake in the morning (but DO hydrate this week!)
- 8:00 AM Arrive in Fayette; unload parade instruments from trailer. Circle Warm-Up and prepare for the parade.
- **9:30 AM** Parade Begins Fulton is the 25th (out of 29) band in the parade. While we will have time before we march, we will spend part of the time in music rehearsal (please be FOCUSED). Be ready to work, but also make sure you rest. We will put on uniforms...probably at the beginning of the Class 2 bands. Remember, we have to play while executing our corner. Be prepared! We'll have 2 left turns and 1 right turn.

When not watching or participating in a Fulton performance, you may watch other indoor competitions or other field competitions. No one is to be hanging out on buses. BE RESPECTFUL the entire day, but especially as you sit in the stands. Everyone has worked very hard for today. Show your support and remember, you never know who's sitting by you. NO football in the parking lots. Please remember to rest throughout the day so that you're at your absolute best for the field show.

- 1:45 PM Gold Rush prepares for performance.
- 2:45 PM Drumline prepares for performance.
- 2:45 PM Indoor Color Guard Performance in Philips-Robb Recreation Center
- 3:45 PM Indoor Drumline Performance in Puckett Field House
- 3:55 PM (or as soon as we're finished watching Gold Rush) Put on uniforms. MOVE WITH PURPOSE!
- 4:15 PM Warm-Up in warm-up area; we'll head to the stadium around 4:45
- 5:00 PM Line up at the stadium
- 5:15 PM FULTON HORNET BAND PERFORMANCE!
- 5:30 PM March back to the trailer and buses, change out of uniform, put everything away...
- 6:00 PM Head back to the stadium to watch the other bands and wait for awards. **Be silent during performances.**
- 7:00 PM Class 4 and 5 Awards
- 7:45 PM (TIME IS APPROXIMATE) Depart for home (let your people know we'll be home in an hour!) Boosters will have a sack dinner for you to eat on the way home. **Please keep the buses clean!**
- 8:45 PM (TIME IS APPROXIMATE) Arrive in Fulton. Clean up buses and take home your belongings! PLEASE make sure the trailer is unloaded and the band room is picked up before leaving!

If you are not riding the bus home, your parent/guardian must sign you out with Ms. Neudecker, Mr. Hiley, or Ms. Diemler after our field show performance.

Important Information from CMU

Route into Fayette

The highways entering Fayette will be blocked off around 9:15 am for the parade, so plan to arrive by 9:00. They will reopen at the conclusion of the parade; approximately noon.

Parking

Parking facilities are at a premium. Only buses and trucks/trailers will be able to park in the band parking areas. There is a specific plan for parking, so bus and support vehicle drivers must follow directions given by parking attendants. No vehicles other than buses, trucks/trailers will be allowed in the parking lots unless directed to do so by CMU. No matter where you park, there will be a bit of walking to get to the performance areas, so please plan some time for travel.

Performances

Included in this packet is a complete schedule for the day. That includes indoor guard and drumline performances, as well as the schedule for all field performances. During any down time, please watch either the indoor drumline performances or the field shows. **At all times, be respectful to EVERYONE AROUND YOU!** It doesn't matter if they can hear you or not. You are representing the Fulton Hornet Band. Disrespect toward other bands, drumlines, guards, leadership, and adults will not be tolerated.

Warm-Up

Unfortunately, there isn't a field for us to do our warm-up on, so we will just do a music rehearsal facing away from the field. We must be at the field ready to perform while the previous band is performing. Please be focused during the entire rehearsal and maintain that focus as we travel to our performance.


