

2023 Class 3 & Class 4 Double Sectional Meet Information

- There will be a single location for all tents at the track meet. Specific sections for tents will be marked off in the grass, in that area. Attached is a map of the facilities with the location of the tent identified. Tents will not be allowed in the bleachers or any location other than the specified tent area.
- For implement check in, each team will need to arrive at the meet with their school name written on the implement. This will aid in the check in process due to the number of implements, athletes and teams. Please try to get implements checked in early. We will weigh in implements on site @ the Throws area. 1st Weigh-In, 8:00-9:00 AM, 2nd Weigh-IN 10:30-11:45 AM.
- The running surface is Poly based synthetic rubber material and will tolerate 3/16 pyramid or 3/16 needle spikes or smaller, larger spikes will result in disqualification. We have a regulation length & width all-purpose javelin runway.
- Here are dimensions of the Long & Triple Jump runways:
Boys: 8',12', 16',21',28',34' & 40' **Girls:** 8',12',21',28',32', & 36'.
- Each field event will have a designated coach's box. Only one coach from each school is allowed to be in the coach's box.
- Athletes will pick up hip numbers and check in for running events in the SW Corner of the track. Athletes will not be allowed to enter the infield unless it is 1st, 2nd or 3rd call for their event. We are encouraging the athletes to use the Mexico HS Soccer field as a designated warm-up area. Athletes will not be allowed to hang out on the infield following their event.
- Chalk or markers will be allowed to be used outside the runways and track surfaces.
- Restrooms are located at Entry Way to the Stadium & under the Home bleachers.
- Buses will unload at South Entrance of the Track Facility and park in the Armory Parking Lot West. Please see Map (Bus Parking).
