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PURPOSE:

The expressed purpose of the Hall of Fame and its Committee is to honor those individuals or teams, regardless of the sport, who had a significant impact on the athletic program at Hammonton High School. Those inducted also have had to project an appropriate positive image of Hammonton High School to the community. Furthermore, it is anticipated that by publicly honoring those individuals, and teams, who have served the Hammonton community so well in the past, the committee will play a role in stimulating and maintaining alumni interest in Hammonton High School as it continues to grow and evolve.

STRUCTURE OF THE HALL OF FAME COMMITTEE:

The Hall of Fame Committee will consist of four permanent positions, namely the high school principal, the athletic director, and two members of the Board of Education set by the Board President as a delegate to the Hammonton High School Athletic Hall of Fame committee. Also, there will be two faculty positions, appointed by the director of Athletics, that will have four-year terms and one position filled by a representative, the president or vice president of the All Sports Booster Club. By his/her choice, the superintendent of schools may serve as a voting or non-voting member.

- Every effort must be made to maintain the structure of the Committee
- If a person is not selected, they will be kept on file and considered in the next process.
- When the committee votes on possible inductees, a majority of five voters must be present.

SELECTION PROCEDURES:

Nominations will be accepted by a pre-determined date. The nominees can come from an application (attached) or the committee.

After nominations are closed, voting of the committee, through a select ballot, will take place.

The members of the committee must be present to vote. A majority vote will determine selection to the Hall of Fame.

ELIGIBLE CATEGORIES FOR INDUCTION:

- Hammonton High School Athlete (individual and team)
- Hammonton School District Employee
- Supporters of Hammonton High School Athletics



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CRITERIA FOR SELECTION:

- To be selected to the Hall of Fame as an Athlete (individual or team), the candidate must;
- Be out of High School for a minimum of five years.
- Be a graduate of Hammonton High School.
- Participated in varsity athletics for Hammonton High School and has excelled as an athlete while achieving individual or team honors and/or impacting the overall athletic program.
- Be an upstanding individual who has demonstrated the high ideals of Hammonton High School.



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HAMMONTON HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETIC HALL OF FAME Bylaws and Procedures

- For individual/team athlete induction, other criteria that should be contributing factors for selection into the Hall of Fame are community involvement, college and/or professional athletic prowess, the number of varsity letters received, number of athletic honors awarded during High School, and records broken during high school.
- These other criteria are considered when casting a vote but are not requirements for induction.
- Team selection - An entire team from a given year can be inducted into the Hall of Fame. This selection type will be considered a team award, not for each individual alone.
- **Hammonton School District Employee:**
 - a. Be employed by the Hammonton School District
 - b. Actively involved in Hammonton athletic programs
 - a. Examples of such an individual are:
 - i. Former Coaches
 - ii. Team Managers
 - iii. Officials
 - iv. Anyone deemed worthy of a nomination by the committee
- **Supporters of Hammonton High School Athletics:**
 - a. Have made significant contributions to the athletic programs at Hammonton High School.

COMMITTEE:

The Committee will organize and implement the award procedures and the type of award that will be presented to the inductee. The award will remain in the school and be standard. Such awards will be designed to be the Committee during the initial year and continued in forthcoming years.

Any amendments to this constitution must be by a majority of the Committee.
