Angela will give Janice the \$6000 for spring sports tomorrow. There might be some leftover because Janice has already made purchases for spring team equipment. She will let us know where the money will be spent.

Spectators: Things are changing frequently. We are now allowed to have 500 spectators per venue, but on May 15, that changes to 1000 spectators. Indoor events are now allowed to have 500 spectators. Community Use sent Janice an email about sports camps being allowed in the building, but she is getting clarification on that. If allowed, 100 participants will be able to attend. VHSL is still on pause with sanctioning events for next season. This could impact some of our tournaments and fundraisers. The tournaments would have to be called Jubilees and no champion, according to VHSL.

August 2 – first tryout date for fall July 27 – golf tryout date

Rising 9th grader event to meet the coaches – Janice is trying to figure this out. She would like to have this by the end of May. It was suggested to broaden this event to current students as well because many didn't play this year because of the pandemic.

Commitment Ceremony – May 17

We have over 18 commits already for this ceremony. This event will be live-streamed for the community.

There is a new VHSL physical form beginning on May 1. This is the only form that is permitted. There is going to be a joint Physical Night on July 19 at West Springfield. Lake Braddock is teaming with West Springfield and South County.

LBABC Scholarships are in the works. Pam has updated the website and all information should be current. The deadline is May 15 and the application is email only.

Questions/Answers:

Some schools have an electronic scanner for tickets – people pre-pay for tickets and then they are scanned electronically. Janice said that a couple of schools are piloting this.
