## Academic Eligibility for Extra Curricular Athletics and Activities

Each week, teachers identify all students who are currently failing. This information is delivered home via the "autocaller," with a message stating that the student is failing one or more classes. Families are encouraged to speak with their student, check his/her grades on Jeffco Connect, and contact the teacher(s) as necessary. These weekly F-grade reports are also used by the Athletic Director and the Activities Director to determine each student's eligibility status for participation in school activities.

## STUDENT ATHLETES

Athletics is an important part of the educational program in that it contributes to the development of good sportsmanship, character, physical development, leadership, general growth and well-being of the participating students. Pomona High School is a 5A member of the Colorado High School Activities Association (CHSAA) and the Jefferson County Athletic League

## Eligibility Requirements

- 1. All athletes are required by CHSAA to enroll in five (5) academic classes per semester or 2.5 credits.
- 2. An athlete cannot have failed more than .5 credit of course work during his/her most recently completed semester to meet state eligibility. (Eligibility may be regained through summer school or correspondence classes.)
- 3. At the time of participation, an athlete cannot be failing more than one (1) academic class or receive more than one (1) unsatisfactory citizenship mark in the same week, or a combination of the two in the same week.
