SPPS athletic events are governed by the Minnesota State High School League

SPPS student conduct at school and district events is governed by the SPPS Rights and Responsibilities Handbook.

IDs

Students from the hosting school and visiting school are welcome with student ID. **No student ID, no entry**.

Students from any other schools/non-participating schools must be accompanied by an adult chaperone.

Middle school students

Middle school students and younger must be accompanied by an adult chaperone.

Re-entry Policy

Fans will not be allowed re-entry once they have exited the building/venue. Exception will only apply in which restrooms or concessions are not within the venue.

Home/Visitor seating

Fans are expected to be in their designated school's section.

Backpacks

Backpacks are not allowed.

Follow rules, regulations, or directions from school staff, stadium personnel, police or security staff. Inability to do so may result in removal from the event.

Event Policies

- No outside food or drink is allowed if concessions are sold on site.
- SPPS Prohibits the following at School Events
 - Weapons
 - Alcoholic Beverages
 - E Cigarettes / Vaping
 - Tobacco
 - Controlled Substances

**Those suspected of being under the influence will not be admitted and are subject to removal from the event.

- Spectators are prohibited from bringing balls into an event.
- Only hand-held signs are allowed. Signs must be positive, appropriate, promote the participants and not be distracting or block the view of others.
- Artificial noise makers are prohibited.
- Only authorized personnel will be admitted onto the playing surface.
- Animals, other than service animals, are not permitted in the event.

Persons who violate these rules may be ejected without refund.
