-Required Mitigation

- ◆ Health & safety of all is the top priority
- ◆ All WJCC, VHSL, VDH & CDC guidelines will be followed at all times
- ◆ All Staff must wear face coverings at ALL times (inside & outside)
- ◆ All players must wear face coverings at ALL times when 6' cannot be maintained during practices & warm ups
- ◆ Upon arrival for practice athletes will remain at their cars until a coach takes their temperature and verifies that they did their WJCC symptom checklist prior to coming to practice. If they have a temperature above 100 they will be sent back home and the trainer and athletic director will be notified.
- ◆ If they have any symptoms for COVID, players should remain at home, notify the coach ASAP.
- ◆ We must have 6' of Social Distancing at all times possible (including in the dugout).
- ◆ Locker Rooms will not be used
- ◆ Players MUST bring their own water to practice and games, 32 oz. minimum

-Tryouts/Practice

Baseball tryouts will begin on Monday April 12th at 3:20 pm. We will have 3 days of tryouts, so it is of the utmost importance that all potential players are present for these 3 days in order for us to have the teams set and begin preparing for the season on Thursday April 15th. All practices will begin at 3:20 and will last until 5:20 with the exception of possibly a handful of practices under the lights if we need to prepare for any night games that we may have

-Equipment

Players are being asked to supply their own batting helmet and bat if possible. We understand that this may be a financial burden to some families and we will attempt to assist as much as possible when and however we can. *Players should NOT* share equipment this year in order to reduce possible exposure. We will take all necessary precautions to help prevent possible exposure.
