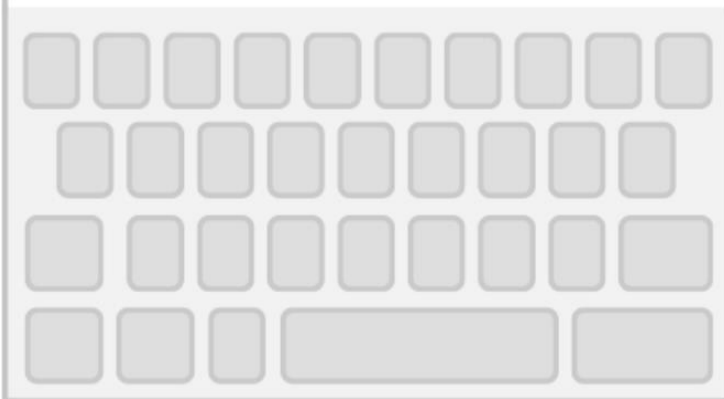

VHSL has banned all energy drinks at sponsored practices or games.



Definition: Drinks advertised as boosting energy.

do not emphasize energy derived from calories they contain

energy is derived through a choice of caffeine, vitamins and herbal supplements the manufacturer has combined.

the FDA does not oversee some of these ingredients.

Examples: Amp, Monster, Rockstar, Red Bull



Warhill will confiscate Energy Drinks if seen and determine whether the athlete is fit to participate that day.

2023-2024 Fall Season

Dear Parent/Guardian:

Beginning with the fall 2012 sports season, WJCC has collected an Athletic Fee from all WJCC student athletes. The High School Athletic fee is \$60 per season (fall, winter, spring). Payment is due prior to the first competition for your student's sport

Now that your student has been selected for a WJCC athletic team, please complete the below form, attach cash or a check, and return the form and payment to your student's school Athletic Director. To make an online payment, visit www.myschoolbucks.com and either register or use an existing account.

This fee will be waived for students who qualify for free or reduced meals. If you qualify and have a completed application on file, you do not need to do anything. If you have not applied, but would be interested in learning more about the Free and Reduced Meal Program, information is available in the front office of each middle school and in the guidance office of each high school.

Please be advised that payment of this fee does not guarantee playing time, which remains at the sole discretion of coaches. The fee is non-refundable.

PARENT INFORMATION

- Academic Requirements

- Minimum 5 credits from previous semester
- Minimum 1.25 GPA from the previous semester

Academic Requirement Appeal Process

- Lacking in **one** required academic area may be appealed **one time during the high school career**
- What can be appealed?
 - GPA expectations

Athletic academic
eligibility/ineligibility is determined
on the date each semester ends





PARENT INFORMATION REQUIREMENTS & RESPONSIBILITIES

- School Attendance
 - Students must be in class a minimum of 3 blocks to participate in practice or contests
 - Exceptions to this requirement can only be made by Administration
 - Student athletes who are tardy the day after an athletic contest excused or unexcused more than two times will be suspended from the next contest
 - Students who have more than 3 UNEXCUSED absences during season – meeting with Student, Parent, Coach, AD, Administrator – eligibility may be affected



PARENT INFORMATION

Procedure to express concerns:

1. Athlete should talk with coach
2. Athlete and parent should make an appointment with coach to meet (not after practice or game!)

If not resolved:

3. Athlete and parent should complete parent communication form and set up an appointment with AD

*Do not approach or confront the coach before, during, or after a game or practice

Consequences of Misbehavior (page 4):



ISS or OSS: prohibited from practice/game during suspension

Second ISS during season may be dismissed from team

Second OSS during season will be dismissed from team



Alternative Classroom Setting (ACS): prohibited from participating in athletics



PARENT INFORMATION

- Fan Sportsmanship Expectation
 - That all spectators will engage in positive fan behavior
 - Let coaches' coach
 - Let officials officiate the contest
 - Inappropriate behavior will result in removal from game
 - Continued inappropriate behavior will result in being banned from athletic events.



VHSL ATHLETE HANDBOOK

- **Sportsmanship**
- VHSL -specific rules
- When an athlete is ejected by a referee, or the unsportsmanlike act is witnessed by the athletic director or principal, the athlete will be suspended based upon VHSL Sportsmanship policy:
 - 20% of Contest Limitations for Profanity directed towards Officials (Example: Football max contest = $10 \times 20\% = 2$ games suspended)
 - 30% of Contest Limitations for Fighting, punching, kicking, stomping an opponent, biting or aggressive physical contact (Example: BB max contest = $20 \times 30\% = 6$)
- Repeated offenses of unsportsmanlike behavior may result in suspension from the team at the discretion of the principal
- Use of Hate Speech, Ethnically or Racially Insensitive Expressions by a coach, player(s), team personnel, towards another will be suspended a minimum of 30% of the total contest limitations. Coming off bench to engage in a fight = 30%

VHSL POLICY - SPORTSMANSHIP

27-16-1 Use of Hate Speech, Ethnically or Racially Insensitive Expressions



Hate Speech-Abusive or threatening speech or writing that expresses prejudice **against a** particular group, especially on the basis of race, religion, or sexual orientation.



Any coach, team personnel and/or contestant who confronts or addresses a coach, contestant or official using hate speech, ethnically or racially insensitive expressions will be disqualified for a minimum of 30% of contest limitations.

HAZING – HARASSMENT – BULLYING
