Bridge Year Expectations and Requirements:

- Students must have met all high school requirements with their class to participate in the bridge year.
- Students/Parents must complete this form by **February 15, 2021**.
- Students will be required to take 9-12 credits during their fall semester of their bridge year. These credits can be taken at the high school, a local community college, or a combination of the two.
- Students will work with the bridge year liaison to develop an individual learning plan for the student. This plan will define academic and co-curricular goals and detail activities and strategies for accomplishing these goals.
- Students will also be required to take 9-12 credits during their spring semester at a local community college.
- Students participating in spring sports during the bridge year can not be considered a full time student at the local community college for the fall or the spring semester and will limit the number of credits accordingly.
- Students must maintain a minimum grade point average of 2.0 to remain in the bridge year program.
- Bridge year students are permitted to participate in **extracurricular activities or spring sports only**. Bridge year students cannot participate in fall or winter sports.
- Bridge year students will be permitted to participate in the graduation ceremonies with their respective class but will not receive a diploma until the conclusion of the bridge year.

I understand that my son/daughter will defer their expected year of graduation to participate in the Bridge Year Program and must adhere to the expectations listed above.
