When in doubt, please ask!!

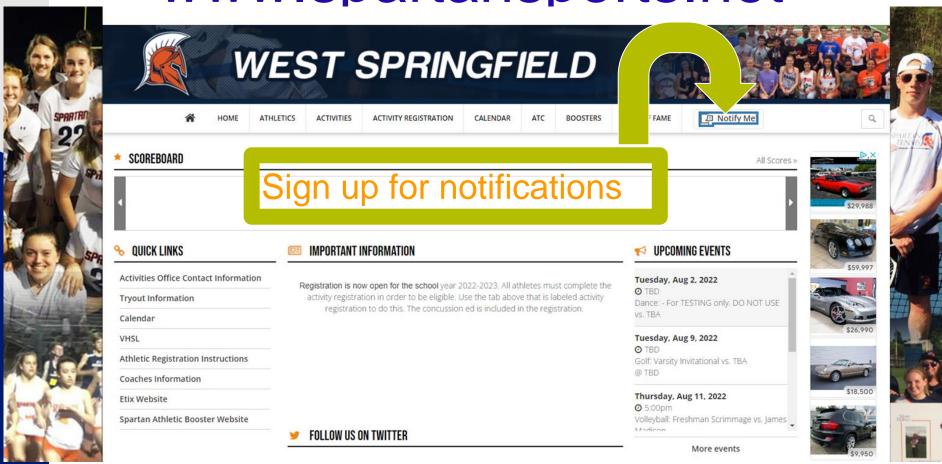

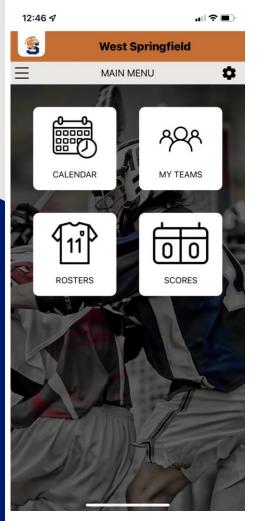

Athletic Training Services

Athletic Training Room access/ services

- After school every afternoon and all home games.
- Injury Evaluation, Rehabilitation, Return to play, Help set up MD appts.

Hours of Operation

After School, unless another time is scheduled with Mr. Worrell











When an Injury Occurs

- Athlete will be evaluated by AT and plan of care made
- Parents will be contacted via phone in event injury considered significant or in need of urgent further care (concussion, laceration needing stitches, fracture, etc)

If MD attention sought or recommended, written documentation from MD required for return to activity

If AT feels injury requires further or specialized care, athlete may be referred to other health-care providers or specialists

Points of Concern

→ Injury Reporting

- Athlete should be reporting injuries ASAP to AT Staff
- If athlete sees MD, note REQUIRED to return to play
- Advised for athlete to see AT prior to seeing
 MD

Concussions

- Managed from academic and athletic perspective
- Annual education required of parents AND students

Points of Concern

- → Specific Medical Conditions
 - Health history
 - Info from PPE
 - Shared with coach
 - ◆ Asthma (inhalers)
 - ◆ Allergies (epi-pens)
 - **◆** Diabetes
 - ◆ Sickle Cell Trait

Return to Play

- → Describes a PROCESS
- → Not a SINGULAR EVENT
- → Demonstrated ability to participate at 100% in practice
